

Financial Support

The conference has applied for a grant from the National Science Foundation (pending now). If funded, partial support will be available to a limited number of recent (5 years or less) Ph.D.s and graduate students who give presentations in the conference. Priority will be given for support of students and new doctorates from under-represented groups in mathematical sciences, U.S. citizens and residents.

Applications and supporting materials must be received by March 31, 2004. Decisions will be made before end of April or after the fund is materialized.

Requests for support should be accompanied by a vita (limited to two pages) and statement of research interests (limited to two pages). Graduate students requesting support should have their advisor send a letter of support.
